Short film by Brazilian-Irish artist selected by Crawford Art Gallery for prestigious global festival to be shown in Triskel Arts Centre

Crawford Art Gallery has invited Brazilian-Irish artist and researcher **Thaís Muniz** to present her film ***The Kite Ballet*** (2024) as part of **Artist Film International 2026** (AFI'26).

This is Crawford Art Gallery's seventh collaboration with AFI and the first time this global touring film programme will be shown in **Triskel Arts Centre** throughout the month of August. Thaís Muniz' film will be shown in participating countries across Europe, Asia and the USA.

Thaís Muniz' film portrays the weekly ritual of kite runners among the Abaeté dunes, sunsets, and prevailing light winds in the Itapuã area of Salvador, Brazil. The community skilfully operates its dancing kites, creating an important physical and symbolic place for Afro-Indigenous



memories and ancestral territory, where lived spiritual practices have existed for centuries.

Highlighting the threat of development to Afro-Indigenous territory in Brazil, Muniz's film advocates for play in adulthood and negotiations with nature as essential, revolutionary acts of resistance. Through the film, she seeks to emphasise the community's activation of the territory while amplifying the voices of local activists.

Artists Film International collectively curates and presents twelve films chosen by international arts organisations across the world. Responding to this year's theme **A Kind of Power**, AFI partners have commissioned or selected international artists whose short films renegotiate the fraught legacies of representation and respond to the conditions under which people, histories, and territories are made visible.

Dawn Williams, curator at Crawford Art Gallery said:

"Tháís Muniz's *'The Kite Ballet'* is an eloquent, beguiling meditation on the power and necessary persistence of playful ritual and resistance. The film gently probes the general loss of play in adulthood yet the balletic movements of the kite flyers and the joy of these community activists who gather weekly, show an alternative way of resisting capitalism's unsustainable and indeterminate growth into natural habitats of indigenous people's lands, which continues to threaten to displace and erode traditional communities in Salvador, Brazil. In its focus on the specific and local, the film speaks to wider geopolitical concerns and the need for deeper care within our communities and a much-needed move towards degrowth."



A public talk with artist **Thaís Muniz and Dr Eve Olney** with Dawn Williams, curator, Crawford Art Gallery will take place on Thursday 27 August at 13:00 – 13:50 at Triskel Arts Centre.

About Thaís Muniz

Thaís Muniz's practice spans multiple mediums to investigate the intersections between inherited and acquired identities, memory, transit, and interior love as a methodology for radical care.

Drawing from a critical engagement with the cultural geography of the places she traverses, Muniz's work is community-oriented and unfolds into collective learning processes such as workshops, performances, installations, and films. Her production also encompasses photography, celebrations, sculptures, and activations, incorporating memorabilia and symbology. Muniz proposes the reimagination of realities through refusal, dreaming, and personal magic, challenging canonical systems of belief and representation.

She holds an MA in Art and Research Collaboration from IADT, Dublin. Her work has been exhibited at the Irish Museum of Modern Art, RHA Gallery, Luan Gallery, and Sirius Arts Centre (Ireland); the Fowler Museum (Los Angeles); the Museum of Contemporary Art in Bahia (Salvador); and A Gentil Carioca (Rio de Janeiro).

About Dr Eve Olney

Dr. Eve Olney is a researcher, consultant and mentor in sustainable creative collaborative practices. She is a founding member of Cork Community Land Trust (cclt.ie) developing social theories of learning through strategies of community building. Olney is currently enrolled in a Post



Doctorate research role, at the Department of Architecture, MTU, entitled, Designing for Difference: Radical Pedagogies in third-level Design/Architecture.

About Artists' Film International:

Artists Film International (AFI) is a prestigious global film programme, originally founded in 2008 by Whitechapel Gallery and since its inception has seen 34 international venues across four continents collaborate. Since 2024 the programme has been convened by London based arts organisation, Forma.

AFI is an alternative, de-centralised programme that exemplifies non-hierarchical, borderless and collaborative curatorial models. Responding to urgent global topics, the programme cultivates collective practice and cross-cultural dialogue, fosters the exchange of ideas and perspectives, and provides wide reaching visibility for artists.

Presented through exhibitions, festivals, and screenings across four continents, the programme creates connections between artists and audiences across distinct social, political, and geographic contexts, foregrounding moving image as a space through which relations, perspectives, and collective forms of attention are continually reshaped.

About Crawford Art Gallery:

Crawford Art Gallery is currently closed to the public for a major redevelopment; Transforming Crawford Art Gallery.



Crawford Art Gallery is an Irish National Cultural Institution (NCI) dedicated to contemporary and historic visual art, located in a significant heritage building in the heart of Cork city. Offering a dynamic programme of temporary exhibitions, it also houses a collection of national importance which tells the compelling story of Cork and Ireland over the last three centuries.

Originally built in 1724 as the city's Custom House, the gallery is home to the famous Canova Casts, gifted to Cork two centuries ago. Featured in the gallery's collection of over 3,500 objects are contemporary Irish and international artists Gerard Byrne, Dorothy Cross, Joy Gerrard, Rula Halawani, Isabel Nolan, Kathy Prendergast, Sean Scully, and Nedko Solakov, as well as much-loved works by artists James Barry, Mainie Jellett, Daniel Maclise, Norah McGuinness, Harry Clarke, Seán Keating, John Lavery, Evie Hone, Patrick Scott, Mary Swanzy and Jack B. Yeats.

About Transforming Crawford Art Gallery:

Crawford Art Gallery is closed to the public and currently undergoing an exciting capital redevelopment project: Transforming Crawford Art Gallery.

This multi-million euro investment will increase gallery space by almost 50%, preserve and protect three centuries of existing built heritage, and create a cultural legacy for a new century as Cork continues to grow.

The project is a Government of Ireland 2040 project funded by the Department of Culture, Communication and Sport in partnership with the Office of Public Works (OPW).

The award-winning Grafton Architects have worked on a [redesign](#) that include a new Learn & Explore facility for public engagement, significant storage for the National Collection, a new entrance, and a



dramatically improved public realm including new café facing onto Half Moon Street as well as additional exhibition spaces. The building's entrance will be reoriented to Emmet Place in line with the original Custom House layout dating to 1724. A large new public gallery space will create a new vantage point for visitors to view city centre landmarks including St Anne's, Shandon and St Fin Barre's Cathedral.

Tá cuireadh tugtha ag **Gailearaí Ealaíne Crawford** don ealaíontóir agus don taighdeoir Brasaíleach-Éireannach **Thaís Muniz** a scannán ***The Kite Ballet*** (2024) a chur i láthair mar chuid de **Artist Film International 2026** (AFI'26).

Is é seo an seachtú comhoibriú idir Gailearaí Ealaíne Crawford agus AFI, agus an chéad uair a thaispeánfar an clár scannán seo, clár atá ar camchuart ar fud an domhain, ag **Ionad Ealaíon Triskel** i rith mhí Lúnasa. Taispeánfar scannán Thaís Muniz i dtíortha rannpháirteacha ar fud na hEorpa, na hÁise agus Stáit Aontaithe Mheiriceá.

Léiríonn scannán Thaís Muniz na deasghnátha seachtainiúla a bhaineann le reathaithe eitleoige i measc dumhaí gainimh Abaeté, agus é ag díriú ar



Iuí na gréine agus ar na gaotha éadroma leanúnacha i gceantar Itapuã i Salvador, an Bhrasaíl. Baineann an pobal úsáid as a eitleoga damhsa go sciliúil agus cruthaítear áit thábhachtach, fhisiciúil agus shiombólach, dá gcuid chuimhní cinn agus dá gcríoch shinseartha a bpobal Afracach-Dúchasach, áit a bhfuil cleachtais spioradálta á gcur i gcrích leis na céadta bliain.

Agus béim á cur ar an mbaol a bhaineann an fhorbairt le críocha Afra-Dhúchasacha sa Bhrasaíl, cuireann scannán Muniz an tábhacht a bhaineann lena bheith ag súgradh do dhaoine fásta chun cinn. Táthar i bhfách na hidirbheartaíochta leis an dúlra mar ghníomhartha riachtanacha réabhlóideacha friotaíochta chomh maith. Tríd an scannán, féachann sí le béim a chur ar an gcaoi a gcuireann an pobal an chríoch i ngníomh, agus ag an am céanna cuireann sí le guthanna na ngníomhaithe áitiúla.

Déanann Artists Film International coimeádaíocht agus cur i láthair ar dhá scannán déag a roghnaigh eagraíochtaí ealaíne idirnáisiúnta ar fud an domhain. Ag freagairt do théama na bliana seo, **A Kind of Power** tá comhpháirtithe AFI tar éis coimisiúnú nó roghnú a dhéanamh ar ealaíontóirí idirnáisiúnta a bhfuil a gcuid gearrscannán ag plé ar bhealach nua le hoidhreachtaí casta na léirithe agus ag freagairt do na coinníollacha faoina ndéantar daoine, stair agus críocha a dhéanamh infheicthe.

Dúirt **Dawn Williams**, coimeádaí ag Gailearaí Ealaíne Crawford:

“Is machnamh cumasach agus mealltach é *‘The Kite Ballet’* le Tháis Muniz ar chumhacht agus ar bhuanseasmhacht riachtanach an deasghnátha spráíúil agus na frithsheasmhachta. Scrúdaíonn an scannán go réidh an cailteanas ginearálta den súgradh a tharlaíonn i measc daoine fásta ach léiríonn gluaiseachtaí bailé den lucht eitilt eitleoige agus lúcháir na ngníomhaithe pobail seo a thagann le chéile gach seachtain bealach

Is institiúid chultúrtha náisiúnta é Gailearaí Ealaíne Crawford atá suite i bhfoirgneamh oidhreachta suntasach i gcroílár chathair Chorcaí, agus atá tiomnaithe do na hamharc-ealaíona, idir stairiúil agus chomhaimseartha. Agus é ag cur clár fuinniúil taispeántas sealadach ar fáil, tá bailiúchán náisiúnta tábhachtach faoina dhíon freisin a insíonn scéal spéisiúil Chorcaí agus na hÉireann le trí chéad bliain anuas.
