Living statues, gallery shenanigans for all the family, talks and tours: Crawford Art Gallery's last Culture Night programme before redevelopment is a big one

Culture Night returns to Crawford Art Gallery on Friday 20 September with a programme brimming with exciting events.

This will be the Cork gallery's last Culture Night for a while, as they are set to close to the public on the evening of Sunday 22 September for Transforming Crawford Art Gallery, their major redevelopment project.

Transforming Crawford Art Gallery will see the gallery increase its space by 50%, will add a stunning new fifth storey public gallery with birds-eye views over Cork city landmarks, and conserve 300 years of built heritage for generations to come. The gallery expects to reopen to the public in mid-2027.

Award-winning Culture Night programming

Crawford Art Gallery has twice won Cork Business Association's "best Cork tourism arts event" for their Culture Night programming, most recently in 2023.

This year, expect the return of last year's popular "living statue," actor Kyle English, who will be bringing the gallery's famous Canova casts to life and having some fun with our guests both inside and outside the gallery.

Visitors can also get involved in some gallery shenanigans with a family-friendly workshop promising chaos and creativity inspired by the Crawford collection.

A programme of stunning live music will see classical guitar, traditional Irish music and more bring the galleries to life into the evening.

For those interested in learning more about what it takes to move over 3,500 precious artworks into storage and embark on an ambitious redevelopment project to conserve and expand Crawford Art Gallery for a new century, a series of “Meet the Team” talks will lift the lid on Transforming Crawford Art Gallery.

For true art-lovers, a series of “Speed-dating the collection” mini tours will provide unmissable insight into the gallery’s best-loved artworks.

About Crawford Art Gallery

Crawford Art Gallery is an Irish National Cultural Institution (NCI) dedicated to contemporary and historic visual art, located in a significant heritage building in the heart of Cork city. Offering a dynamic programme of temporary exhibitions, it also houses a collection of national importance which tells the compelling story of Cork and Ireland over the last three centuries.

Originally built in 1724 as the city's Customs House, the Gallery is home to the famous Canova Casts, gifted to Cork two centuries ago. Featured in the gallery's collection of over 3,000 objects are contemporary artists Aideen Barry, Gerard Byrne, Maud Cotter, Dorothy Cross and Sean Scully as well as much-loved works by Irish artists James Barry, Harry Clarke, Mainie Jellett, Seán Keating, Daniel Maclise, Norah McGuinness and Jack B. Yeats.

About Transforming Crawford Art Gallery

Crawford Art Gallery closes in Autumn 2024 for two years to undergo an enormously exciting capital redevelopment project.

This multi-million euro investment will increase gallery space by 50%, preserve and protect three centuries of existing built heritage, and create a cultural legacy for a new century as Cork continues to grow.

The project is a Government of Ireland 2040 project funded by the department of Tourism, Culture, Arts, Gaeltacht, Sport and Media in partnership with the Office of Public Works (OPW).

The award-winning Grafton Architects [have worked on a redevelopment design](#) that includes a new Learn and Explore facility for public engagement, significant storage for the National Collection at Crawford, a new entrance, and a dramatically improved public realm including new café facing onto Half Moon Street.

The building's entrance will be reoriented to Emmet Place in line with the original Customs House layout dating to 1724.

A large new public gallery space will be created five stories above Cork City, creating a new vantage point for visitors to view city centre landmarks including Shandon and St Finbarre's Cathedral.

Filleann Oíche Chultúir ar Ghailearaí Ealaíne Crawford ar an Aoine 20 Meán Fómhair agus tá clár againn atá lán le himeachtaí corraitheacha!

Beidh sé seo an Oíche Chultúir deireanach ón ngailearaí i gCorcaigh ar feadh tamaill, mar gheall go mbeidh siad dúnta don phobal tráthnóna Dé Domhnaigh, 22 Meán Fómhair do Chlaochlú Ghailearaí Ealaíne Crawford, a dtogra mór-athfhorbartha.

Tiocfaidh méadú 50% ar spás an ghailearaí le Claochlú Ghailearaí Ealaíne Crawford, agus cuirfear an cúigiú hurlár álainn leis an ngailearaí poiblí a thugann radharc ón spéir anuas ar shainchomharthaí chathair Chorcaí, agus 300 bliain d'oidhreacht tógtha a chaomhnú do na glúnta atá le teacht. Táimid ag súil go mbeimid ag athoscailt don phobal i lár 2027.

Clár don Oíche Chultúir a bhfuil duaiseanna buaite aige

Bhain Gailearaí Ealaíne Crawford an duais do Chumann Gnó Chorcaí “imeacht ealaíon turasóireachta is fearr i gCorcaigh” as a gclár d'Oíche Chultúir, le gairid in 2023.

I mbliana, bí ag súil le “dealbh bheo” ag filleadh arís ó anuraidh, an t-aisteoir Kyle English, a chuirfidh beocht arís i múnlaí cáiliúla Canova an ghailearaí agus beidh spraoi aige lenár n-aíonna laistigh agus lasmuigh den ghailearaí.

Is féidir le cuairteoirí páirt a ghlacadh i ndiabhláocht an ghailearaí le ceardlann oiriúnach do theaghlaigh a gheallann rírú agus cruthaitheacht a fuair spreagadh ó bhailiúchán Crawford.

Agus é ag cur clár fuinniúil taispeántas sealadach ar fáil, tá bailiúchán náisiúnta tábhachtach faoina dhíon freisin a insíonn scéal spéisiúil Chorcaí agus na hÉireann le trí chéad bliain anuas.
