

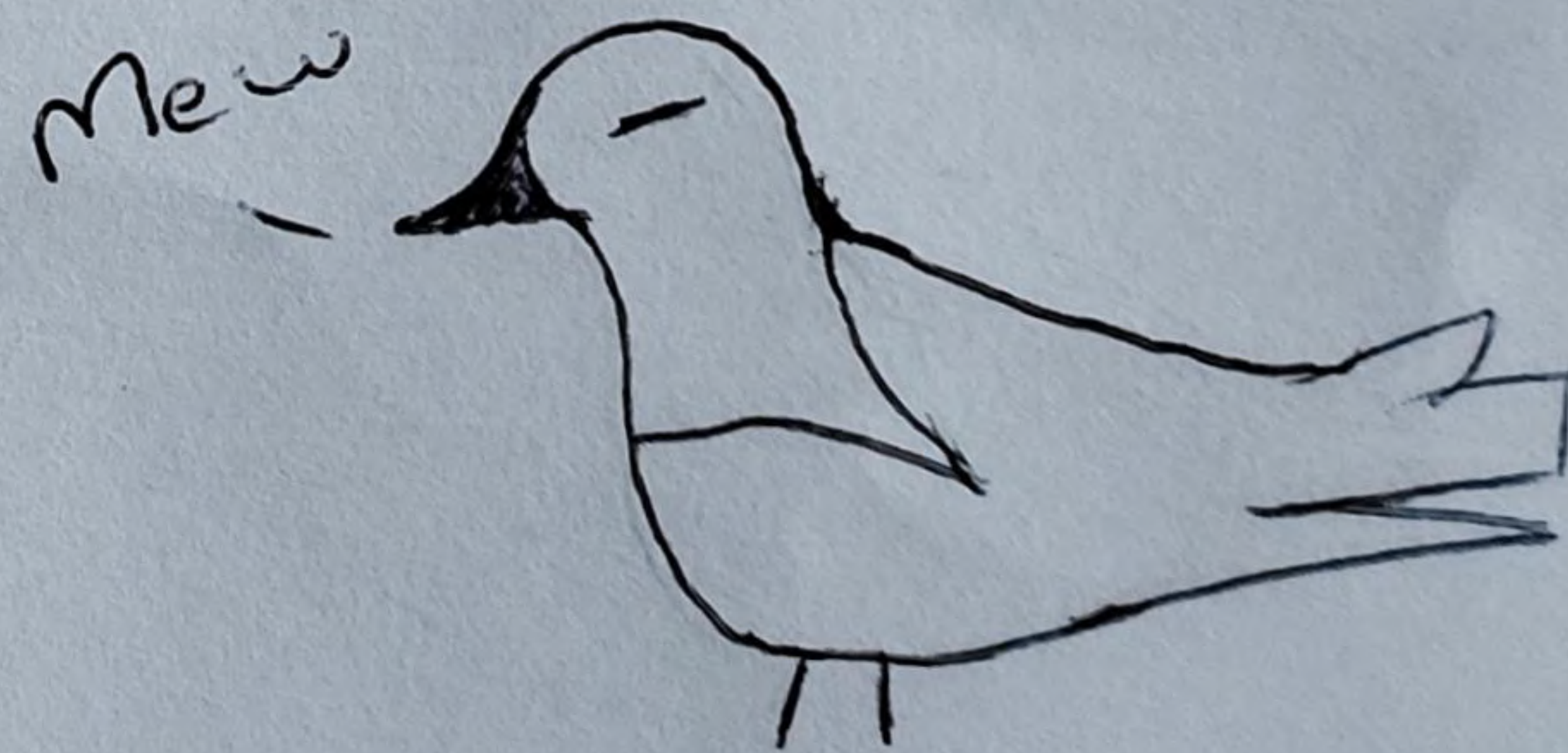
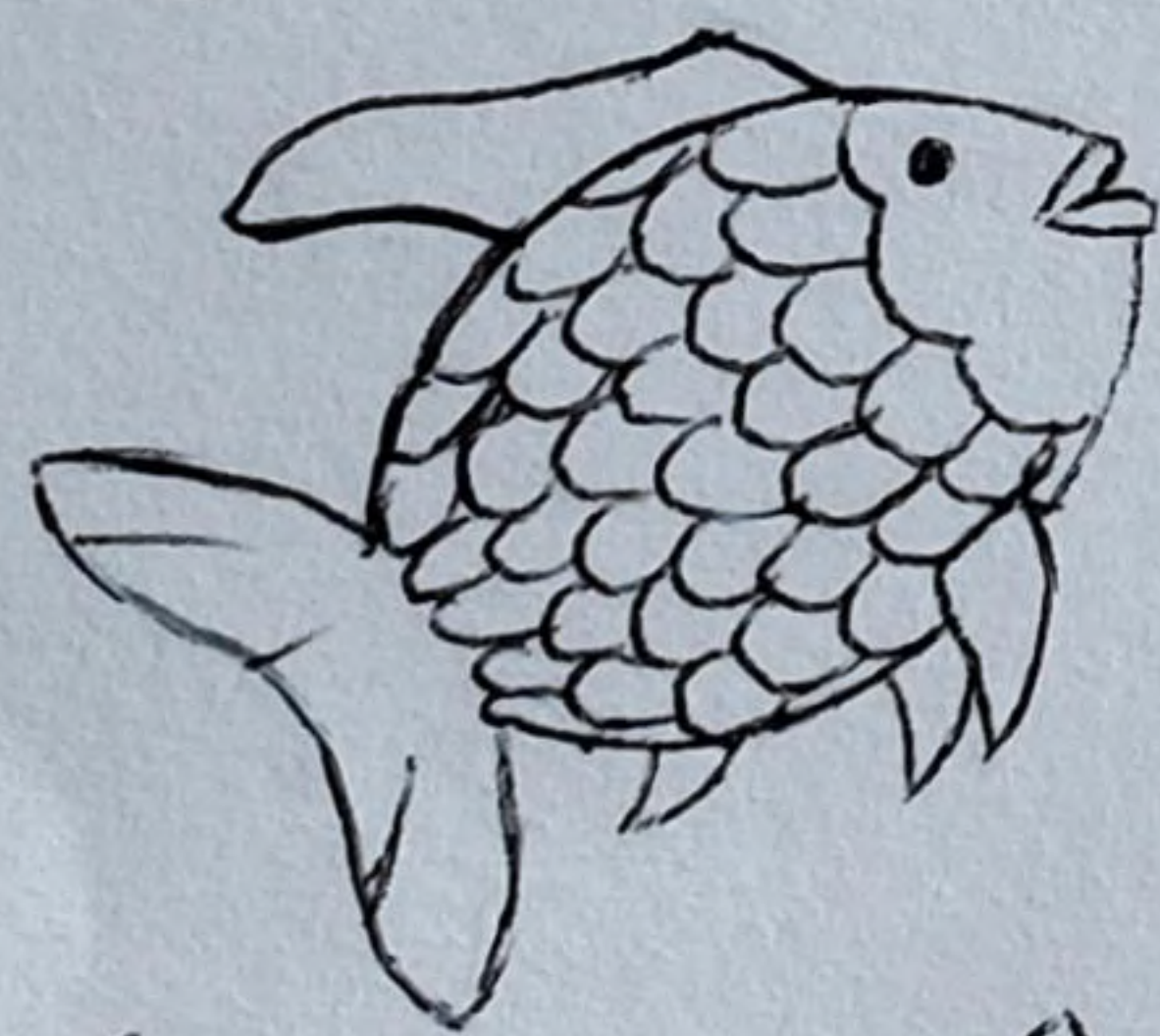

The exhibition explores the observations of behaviours of domesticated and wild animals in circuses, at home and in their natural habitats.



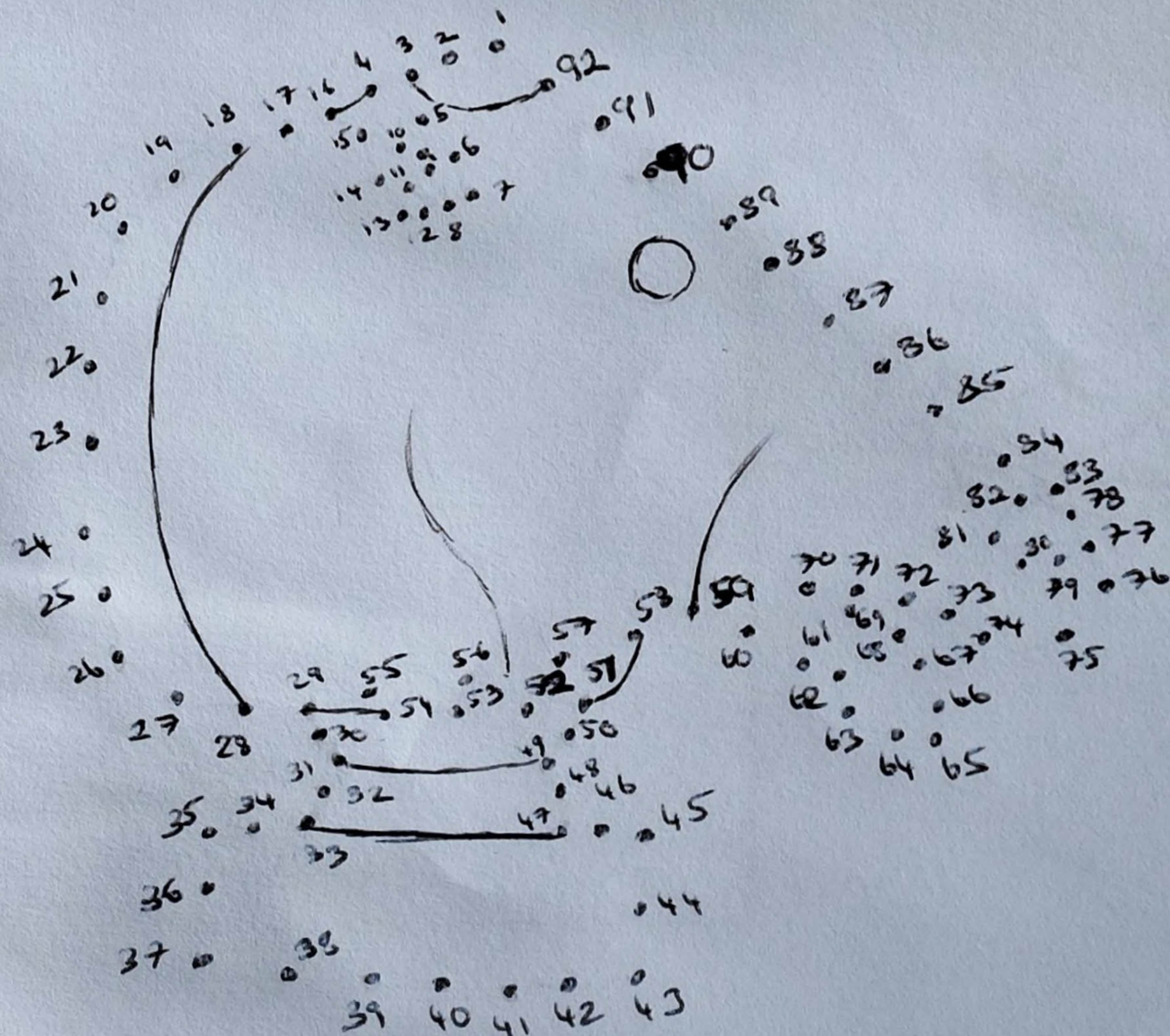

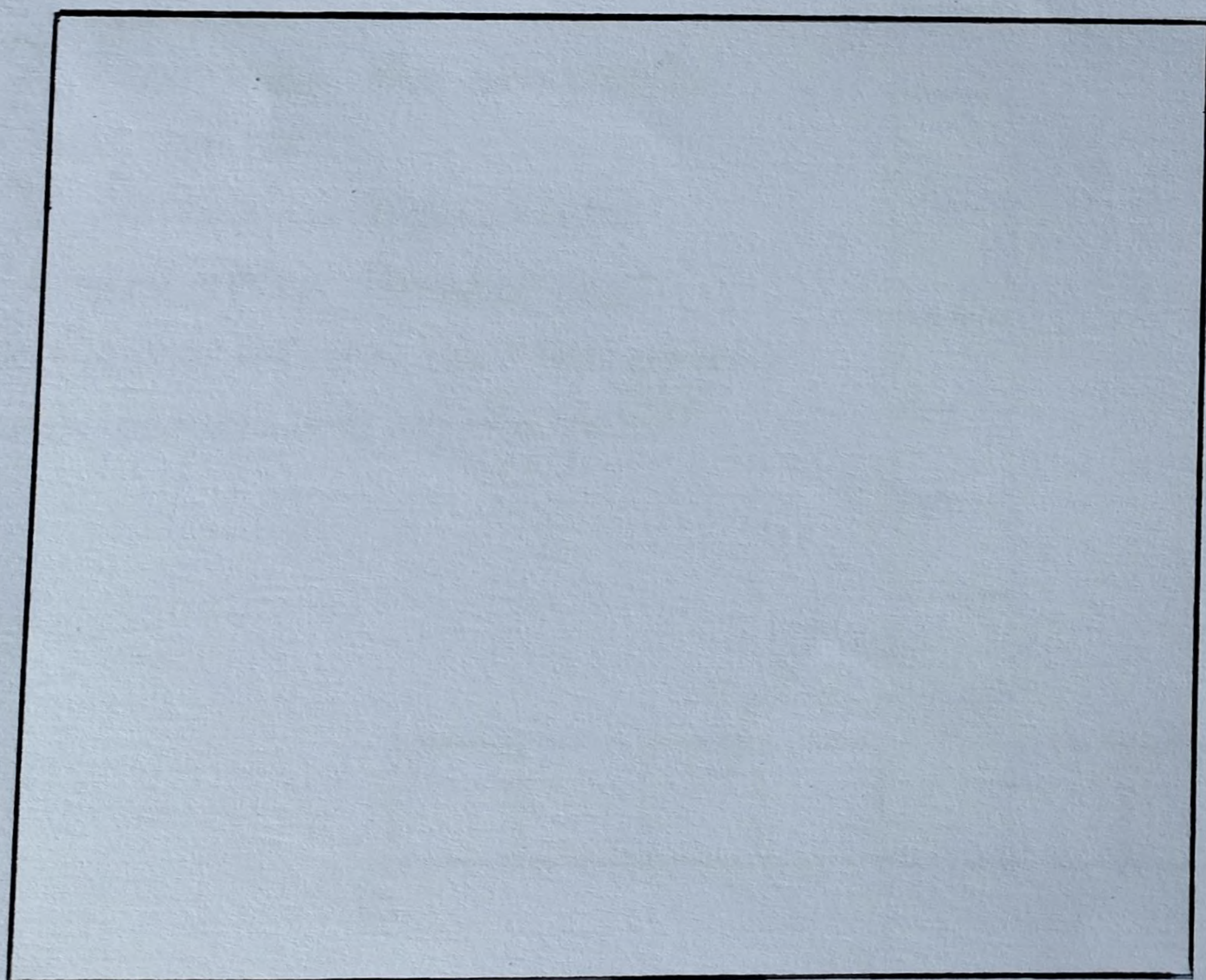

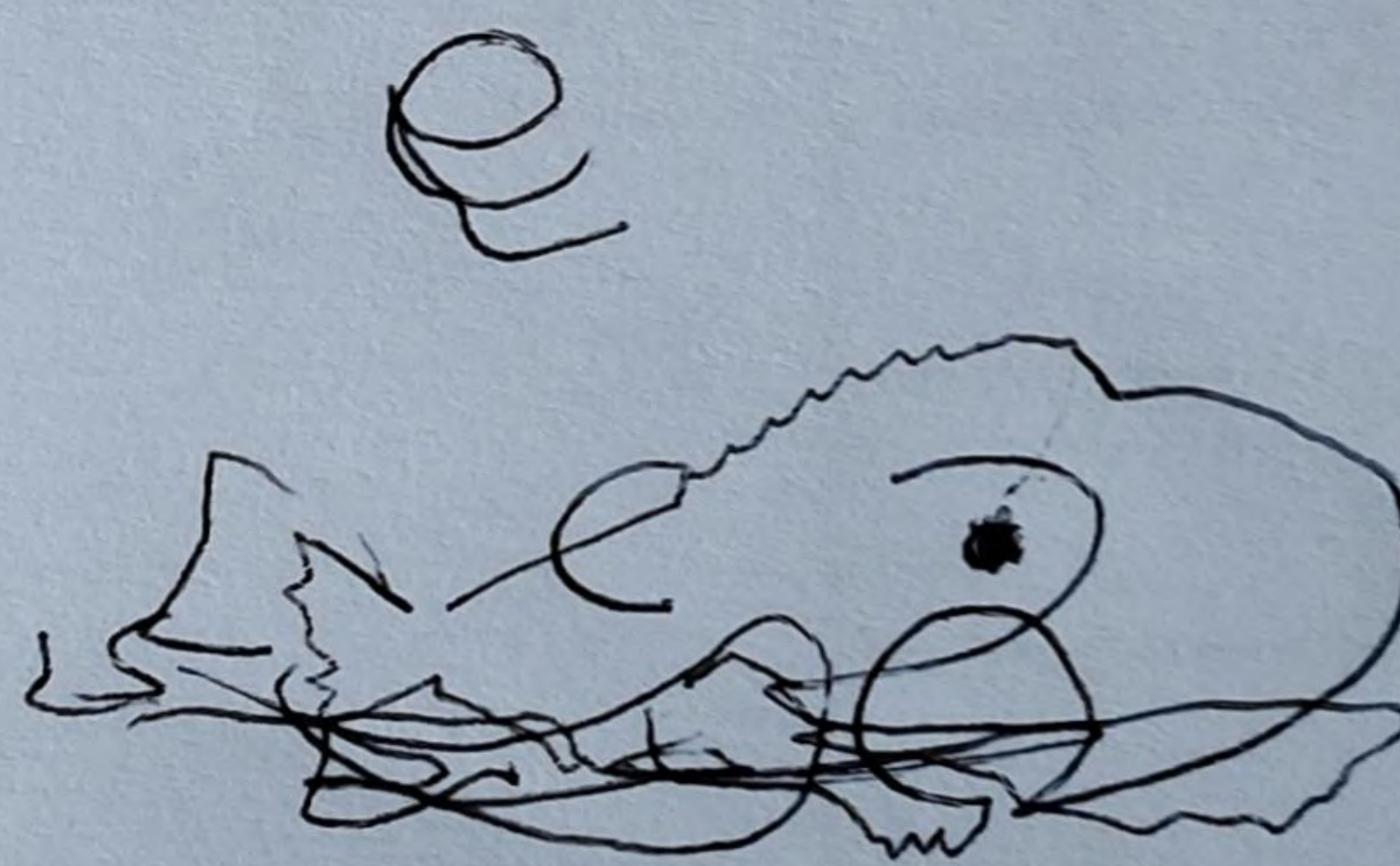
Blind Drawing

Pick an object or painting in your surroundings. Once your pencil or pen touches the page, you mustn't lift it until you have completed your drawing. You mustn't look at your page until you're finished.

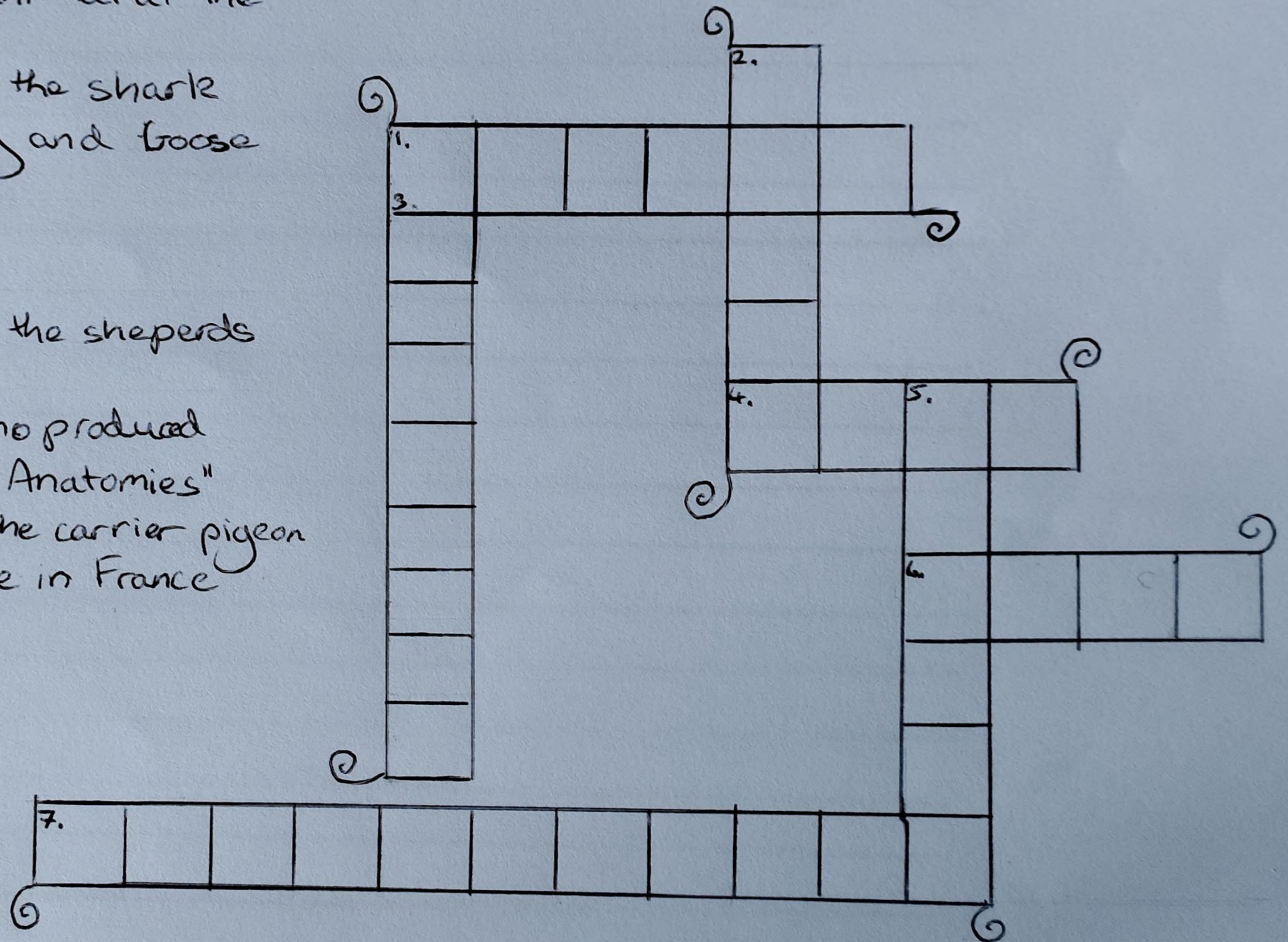

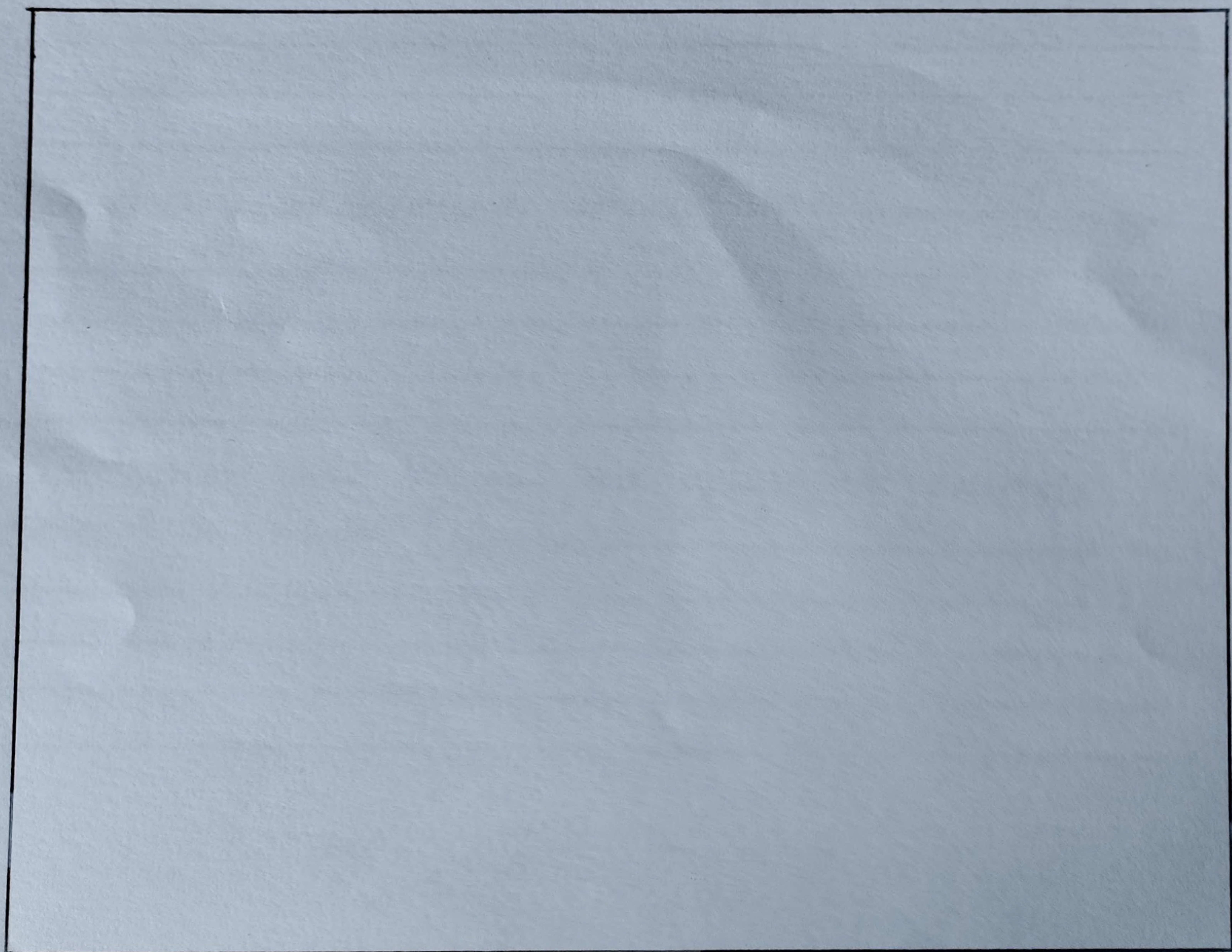
